

MAINTENANCE / CARE

- 1. Inspect all parts on the winch, winch mount, and related hardware prior to each use. Replace all hardware that appears rusted or deformed.
- 2. Inspect all nuts and bolts on the winch, winch mount and related hardware prior to each use. Tighten all nuts that appear to be loose. Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts need to be replaced.
- 3. Check all cables prior to use. Replace cables that look worn or frayed.
- 4. Check all moving or rotating parts. Remove debris that may inhibit the part from moving freely.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. The Warn Elite Skid Plate cover works for all trims of the JL, however the installation is slightly different between the steel bumpers and plastic bumper models.

For steel bumper models:

NOTE: You will not use the included skid plate brackets.


- a. With assistance, align skid plate mounting hole with existing bottom holes of factory bracket.
- b. Secure skid plate by threading one bolt (B1) through skid plate and factory bracket. *Do not fully tighten at this time to allow for further adjustment*.
- c. Repeat for other side.

For plastic bumper models:

- a. Remove the two nuts from bolts in bumper/frame (each side).
- b. With assistance, align skid plate bracket holes with existing bolts in frame.
- c. Secure skid plate bracket (A2 or A3) to bolts with factory nuts. Repeat for other side.





- d. Secure skid plate to skid plate bracket bottom mounting hole by threading one bolt (B1) through skid plate and bracket and fasten with nut (B2). *Do not fully tighten at this time to allow for further adjustment*.
- e. Repeat for other side.



For all models:

a. Align the skid plate holes to match the holes on vehicle bumper.

- b. Insert fastener (B1) into the center of skid plate cover and fasten with provided nut (B2).
- c. Repeat for rest of the holes (five total).

2. After all the fasteners are in, tighten ALL fasteners to 18.8 ft-lbs.

The skid plate cover should look like this after installation.
